- High school drop-out program for youth and young adults, ages 16 to 24
  - Goals are to improve reading, writing and math skills
  - Obtain a GED and become employed
  - Classes located at the Everett Transit Center WorkSource (Learning Center)
  - Certified teacher leads students through life skills and career exploration activities
  - Students work with Employment Specialists to pursue employment, higher education, soft and life skill development
  - Assist students with career exploration, retention and intensive case services
  - Addressing employment barriers and placing students in short term subsidized training with local companies to gain job readiness skills

## ALL INDIVIDUALS ENROLLING IN THE PROGRAM MUST PROVIDE

- ▶ **Social security card**
- ▶ **Birth certificate**
- ▶ **Current State identification** - Identification card, permit or driver's license
- ▶ **Proof of income** - DSHS letter verifying amount of food stamps and or TANF; Verification of UI receipt; or Wages (if worked in the past 6 months)
- ▶ **If in foster care** - letter from DSHS stating dependency
- ▶ Or Proof of disability
